Matthew - I try to make a good impression to my girlfriend's family by beating them badly (emphasis on bad).

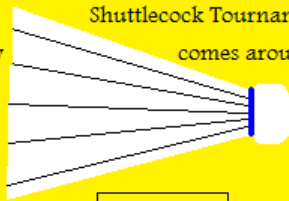
Travis - It's so much fun to be with the whole family!
